You are completely free to refuse to provide your consent, and will not be asked to provide reasons, should you choose to do so. However, we are happy for you to give us additional information if you choose, so that we understand any concerns that you have and take appropriate steps where necessary.

Photographs and Videos

Photographs and videos are used for a number of purposes in schools (e.g. teaching and learning, security, celebrating student success, staff training). Images, which the school holds, are stored securely and are only used in line with consent. Where there are opportunities to share successes with the public in the media about student success, and school events, this again will be in line with consent. (When images have been submitted to or taken by the media, they are then subject to that media's own data protection procedures.)

Celebrating Your Achievements and Promoting the School

As a School, we are very proud of the achievements of our students, and we want to be able to celebrate these achievements within School and with others (e.g. in sport, the arts etc.). We may also want to report on significant events which involve our students, such as visits from dignitaries.

Paying for Meals/Drinks and Using the Library

The School uses a fingerprint recognition system for paying for meals/drinks and using the library. The system works by using an image of the fingerprint to create a mathematical algorithm and then deletes the fingerprint. Only the numbers remain and these cannot be re-interpreted back into a fingerprint image. This data is stored on a secure school server.
